Thanksgiving Turkey Pre-Ordering Announcement

Are you hosting a Thanksgiving distribution this year and need turkeys? Look no further!

The Central Texas Food Bank is asking agencies to please fill out this <u>survey</u> to pre-order turkeys by **Friday**, **Oct. 15th at 5:00 PM.** CTFB is expecting turkeys to arrive at the Food Bank throughout October and early November. CTFB hopes to accommodate all requests however this opportunity is first come, first serve.

They should be between 10 and 12 pounds at about \$1.31/pound. This is how that breaks down.

- 1 turkey approximately costs \$15.72*
- 1 case (of 4 turkeys) approximately costs \$62.88*

In the <u>survey</u>, please provide details on your distribution such as if it is open to the public, where is it located, and what kind of distribution model you are using. Please identify a range of dates you are able to accept your turkey order from the Food Bank so we can begin coordinating with our Transportation team. If you are able to pick up your turkeys from the Food Bank, please let us know.

Thank you for the great work you all are doing in our communities, we are looking forward to an exciting holiday season!


CTFB is pleased to announce that we've updated our Shop For policy. Effectively immediately, 2 people can access Shop-For at a time while maintaining social distancing of 6 ft. We ask that there be only **one person per agency** present while shopping to ensure the upmost safety. We hope that by allowing two agencies to shop at a time that things will operate at a much quicker pace. Thank you for your compliance as we work together on a more efficient process. IMPORTANT NOTICE – The annual inventory closure dates have changed and expanded. Please review the updated closure information immediately and note if your agency will be affected. In order to conduct our annual inventory, CTFB will be closed and cannot accommodate order pick-ups and deliveries from Monday, September 27 to Friday, October 1. No orders will be received during this closure, however, we will have shop-for appointments only available on Friday, October 1st. This means all regularly scheduled pick-ups and deliveries are cancelled during this time. Below are the modifications being made to the ordering schedule as a result of this closure:

Annual inventory is an important process that allows us to ensure our tracking systems are as accurate as possible in order to reduce future errors on orders. If your organization will be in need of a rescheduled pick-up during this closure, please reach out to your relationship manager to see what may be possible. Reschedule spots will be limited and are available first-come, first-served. CTFB will remain open for normal business operations the week prior to the new inventory closure dates. We apologize for any inconvenience caused by this change and appreciate your patience and flexibility as we work through our annual inventory count.
