Guidelines for Donated Food

Thank you for helping to feed our Central Texas neighbors facing hunger! Please follow these guidelines to ensure that all donated food is safe and edible:

- All donated food must be in its original packaging, unopened, with no loss of sanitary barrier.
- All donated food must be labeled.
- No donations should be left outside.
- Do not donate food kept in a danger zone (41°F-135°F) for more than 2 hours.
- Donations from each department should be stored separately.

ACCEPTABLE





Frozen Meats

- Frozen by use-by date
- Separated by species



- Discoloration
- Torn packaging
- Defrosted/refrozen



Produce

- Wholesome, edible
- Cosmetic damage/minor decay



Produce

- Mold
- Severely decayed



Dairy/Eggs

- Up to use-by date
- Egg cartons with broken eggs removed



Dairy/Eggs

- Curdled or molded items
- Leaking items



Bread/Bakery

No mold

Non-Perishable/Dry Grocery

- Cosmetic Damage
- Discontinued/seasonal items



Non-Perishable/Dry Grocery

- Cans with major dents or punctures
- Missing label
- Open/exposed



Non-Food Items

- Paper/plastic goods
- Personal items, diapers



Non-Food Items

- Leaking or open items
- Broken aerosol cans
- Items which need repair
