Hunger Fighter T-shirts

For the very first time, the Food Bank has a public, online merchandise store to sell Hunger Fighter T-shirts! The purpose of this new online store is to give members of the public an opportunity to buy a CTFB shirt to support our mission. While we plan to continue providing our partner agencies with free t-shirts, branded items and other supplies, we know that we simply cannot provide enough merchandise for all the wonderful volunteers and staff at your organizations. Shirts are \$25 each plus \$5 for shipping. After you complete your purchase, the Food Bank will mail your order.

We hope to expand the store to include other items, but for now, we are very excited for this launch just in time for the holidays!

Advocacy Updates

CTFB has been actively advocating for the restoration of recent cuts to the Surplus Agricultural Products Grant in the Texas Department of Agriculture's FY20-21 budget. As of October 1, the program experienced a 44% budget cut, which represents a loss of 1.5 million pounds of fresh produce that our food bank will not be able to procure this year. Restoring funding for this critical program will be a top priority for our network in the upcoming legislative session, and we welcome your help in our outreach to state legislators.
