Training Reminder:

This is a reminder to check your agency's training certificates and ensure they are still valid! The Central Texas Food Bank requires all partner agencies to be trained in Food Safety and Civil Rights. A member of your agency staff either must be a certified food manager (sites serving meals) or have received food handling training (sites distributing groceries) from an accredited school or the local health department while adhering to all local and state food safety guidelines.

In addition, all agency staff and volunteers who interact with program participants and handle personal information must receive Civil Rights training, which is offered online through the Texas Department of Agriculture. All temporary/short-term volunteers must review the limited civil rights training document located in the Agencies Resource Center on the website. Partner Agencies are responsible for documenting their training records and will need to be on file with CTFB. Failure to comply with this training requirement may result in a suspension of privileges with the Food Bank. If your training certificates are expired, please follow the suggested training links below. Please send updated certifications to your Agency Relations Specialist!

*Note for the Civil Rights training: Please review these instructions to ensure we receive a confirmation of your training. You can enter your relationship manager's email address as an alternative email address at the end of the training, or you can forward it to them once you receive the

confirmation in your inbox. Your training confirmation is not sent automatically to the food bank or TDA unless you follow the instructions above!
