TEFAP Signature Requirement – Updated Intake Forms

The Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) has recently removed the signature requirement for household eligibility for USDA Foods. This means that <u>clients</u> <u>are no longer required to provide a signature on the Pantry Intake Form in</u> <u>order to receive food assistance.</u> All information on the form remains self-declared and clients must read the certification statement.

Please note, staff/volunteers must still complete and sign the certification section, and the process for determining eligibility based on categorical, income, or crisis need remains the same.
