Zero Waste Business Incentives and Rebates

The City of Austin's Zero Waste Business Rebate is an incentive for businesses to improve their waste reduction and diversion practices. Eligible businesses can receive up to \$3,000 for reducing waste beyond the minimum requirements of the Universal Recycling Ordinance. More info can be found on their <u>website</u>.

Eligible Rebates Include:

Expanding food donation programs to people or to a charitable food organization - Up to \$3,000 in rebates available for:

- Cold food storage like freezers and refrigerators.
- Non-perishable food storage like shelves and bins.
- Equipment for transporting food like coolers and vacuum seal bags.

Starting or expanding your compost program at your property or business - Up to \$3,000 in rebates available for:

- Six months of commercial organic hauling service.
- Indoor collection containers.
- Compostable bags.

Rebates are available on a first-come, first-served basis and there is a limited amount of funding available for each category. The application closes July 1, 2023 or once all funds are allocated. Review the rebate <u>terms and conditions</u> and submit a <u>rebate application</u>. Apply today!
