

WAREHOUSE VOLUNTEER LEADER WANTED!

Do you want to use your logistics skills to help fight hunger? As a Warehouse Volunteer Leader, you will be instrumental in working with public volunteers to ensure all the food we distribute is safe, healthy and high quality for our clients in need. You'll lead volunteers, helping them learn to inspect, clean, sort, box and prepare food donations to be ready for distribution to our Partner Agencies and the families they serve.

The Warehouse Volunteer Leader will:

- Assist Product Recovery staff with project set-up and break-down.
- Train volunteers on the task/s they have been assigned to. This will include training on how to use equipment such as a tilter, manual pallet jack, compactors, and utility knives.
- Help ensure that all volunteers are following correct food safety protocol during a shift (handling, sanitizing, packing, disposal, etc.).
- Aid in the supervision of volunteer groups so that we maintain a safe work environment.

If you are interested in helping feed your neighbors by becoming a Volunteer Leader at the Central Texas Food Bank, consider becoming a Warehouse Volunteer Leader. No prior knowledge or experience is needed, but we do require that you commit to coming at least once a week for 4 months.
